(Gee Gee Rugwash Scottish Points League)

Dressage: Classes 1 to 5 - BC Test 1B (2009) [80 x 40]

Classes 6 to 8 - BC Novice 80 (2013) [80 x 40]

Marathon: 3 Sections approximately 12 km. Short marathon (9km) for classes 5, 6, 7 and 8 Section A starts with approximately 2 km of tarmac road with the remainder on undulating farmland. The short Section A will be on hard tracks. Section B will have 6 obstacles which utilise the natural terrain, including water. *Information for competitors who have competed at Biggarshiels before: - it is planned that the steep incline previously in the first 2 km of section B will instead be incorporated into the transfer section, thus resulting in a less challenging section B.*

Cones: To be driven after dressage.

Closing Date for Entries: Friday 11th August.

Location: - Biggarshiels Farm is 13 miles from the Abington Services or 22 miles from the Edinburgh bypass. Follow the A702 to Biggar. Take the B7016 to Carnwath (left turn from Abington direction and right turn if you have come from Edinburgh.) Fork right, where the road bends left, into Biggarshiels Road. Biggarshiels is approximately ½ mile from the fork and 400m past the entrance drive, you will find the parking field on the right hand side.

Competitors' information:-

- Competitors may choose to compete in any of one, two or three phases. (Dressage, Cones or Marathon). Only three phase competitors will score points towards the Gee Gee Rugwash Scottish Points League.
- One Day Event option (three phases) available for Sunday by prior arrangement.
- There will be a wine reception and competitors' briefing, followed by a barbecue on the Saturday evening.
- Dressage times will be posted on the SCDA website on **Wednesday 23th August.**
- **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES AND MUST REMAIN WITHIN THE PARKING FIELD.** This is out of consideration for the neighbours' sheep.
- Please do not use portaloos for emptying cassettes if at all possible.
- **Please bring blocks if you need to level your lorry / caravan as the parking field slopes.**
