**Stabling:** Please report to the stable manager on arrival and wait to be directed to a parking area. Horseboxes, caravans and portable stabling will be welcome in the area allocated as the stable field from Friday 27 July at noon. Earlier access may be available on request. There would be no guarantee of all services being available prior to the 27<sup>th</sup>. Rubber matting must be used on all stables and corrals. Electric fencing can be used with prior arrangement with the event organiser and there will be a designated parking area. **Matting is compulsory under bedding in portable stabling at all National events. A payment to cover the cost of restitution of the ground may be levied for non-compliance.**

**Marathon Information:** Marathon consists of mainly forestry tracks and fields. The course has been significantly upgraded since the event's inception. Further works have been carried out this year again to improve the course and take account of competitors' feedback.

**Interclub Challenge:** Affiliated Clubs may enter a team to include 1 Single Pony, 1 Single Horse and 1 Multiple (pair, tandem or four). Points will be allocated upon final placing of each team member within their respective class. Team members must be nominated by 0900 Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> July.
