SCOTTISH POINTS LEAGUE 2015

1. The league is only open to SCDA Full members.
2. Points are available in all classes, except Leisure classes which do not qualify for points, at all SCDA Club events in Scotland, and in Club classes at British Carriagedriving Regional and National events in Scotland. Points are not available at SCDA Grassroots and Indoor events.
Points are also available to SCDA members who compete in the Advanced, Open, Intermediate and Novice classes at those National and Regional events where Club classes are also available (eg at Raehills, but not at Hopetoun). These points will be recorded in the relevant Club category of the points league alongside those points scored by SCDA members in the Club classes. *Example: Advanced Single Pony in Club Single Pony; Intermediate Pony Pairs in Club Pony Pairs, and so on. It will thus be possible for there to be more than one score of 10 points, for example, in the Club category of the points league for Raehills.)*
At regional events where club and national competitors drive the same number of obstacles points will be apportioned to the relevant points league class from across the classes.
3. The league points will be awarded in the above classes as follows: 10 points for the highest placed SCDA member, 9 points for second highest, 8 points for third highest, and so on to 1 point for tenth place.
Examples:
SCDA member winning class at a Club event (Falkland): 10 points.
SCDA members coming third and fourth behind two non-SCDA members at a Club event (Dalmeny): 10 points and 9 points respectively.
SCDA member coming second behind a non-SCDA member in a Club class at a National class in a regional event in Scotland: 10 points.
SCDA member coming third behind two non-SCDA members in Intermediate Horse class at a National in Scotland where Club classes were also available: 10 points (recorded in the Single Horse category in the league points. It is therefore possible for more than one SCDA member to have 10 points recorded in the Single Horse class, for example, at Raehills: the third placed in the Intermediate class above, and the winner of the Single Horse club class).
4. The maximum number of events that will count towards a member's points league placing will be one less than the number of events taking place. A competitor's best placings will be used to calculate his/her points total if he/she has competed in more than the number of eligible events. A member's points will count irrespective of which horse or pony he/she is driving in a particular class. If the member competes in a different class, separate points will be awarded for the different class. A member competing with two separate turnouts in the same class will gain points from the highest placed turnout only.
5. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the competitor with the lowest aggregate marathon score in the events which the tying competitors have in common.
