Alternative option for Club Open Singles and Pairs only – FEI Test CAI-2*HP1(v3) [80 x40]

Regional Dressage: as per BC schedule.

Gateway Dressage: as per BC. Please advise if your vehicle is not standard wheel width.

Marathon to be driven on Sunday 31st July 2 Sections approximately 15 km, with up to 7 obstacles (which will include water) for Regional Classes, reduced marathon for other classes.

Location: - Deer Park, Hopetoun Estate, Newton, Winchburgh, West Lothian, EH30 9SL.

A904, via A90 or M9. In the village of Newton, turn north down the road signposted to Abercorn Church; pass the Parkhead Cottages on a narrow Z bend, ¼ mile further on down the hill turn right into the Deer Park through the security gates over a cattle grid.

Stabling: Stabling Field opens 2 p.m. on Thursday. Please report to the stable manager on arrival and wait to be directed to a parking area. Rubber matting must be used on all stables and corrals. Electric fencing can be used with prior arrangement with the event organiser and there will be a designated parking area.

Only limited Electric Hooks up available. Please notify Entries Secretary of electric hook up requirement when entering for the event and add payment of £100 to your entry fee. Generators will be turned off between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Caravans and additional vehicles: £10 per extra caravan, after the first one per competitor.

ATVs/Scooters: May be used to access the forward parking area at the obstacles at competitors' risk. Not to be used in the obstacles as per BC rules.

Dogs: Dogs on leads only.
