Marathon: (From 09.30 Sunday) 3 Sections with 6 Obstacles. Section A of approx. 5k of undulating tracks and farmland; 500m Transfer; 6k Section B with 6 obstacles within the estate.

Young Drivers - Section B only. **Club Novice Class** - Shortened section A.

Cones: To be driven after dressage.

(Bring your own food and drink to a central BBQ area, subject to government guidelines).
- Beach. While we are very fortunate to have a lovely beach at Seacliff, as this is open to members of the public there will be a strict no horse policy on the beach between the hours of 08.30 until 20.30.
- ATV's/Scooters: Motorised vehicles permitted provided relevant insurances are in place. We reserve the right to restrict vehicles to specific areas only, should it be required. If special requirements are needed, please contact Jamie/Rebecca March.
- Please report to the stable manager on arrival and wait to be directed to a parking area. Rubber matting **must** be used on all stables and corrals and **must** cover full area of stabling and electric fenced corrals. Electric fencing can be used with prior arrangement with the event organiser and there will be a designated parking area.
