**Dressage:** IHDT UK Precision and Paces Test – 2023/2024 Season, version 1.2.11 (*i.e. not the 2025 version*).

**Lunch:** Bring your own picnic and picnic chair and enjoy the company of other competitors at lunchtime.

**Drive:** Optional circuit of 2.5 miles on quiet roads. Available at any time, but particularly good as a warm-up circuit before obstacle/cones phase.

**Obstacles/Cones:** Marathon wheel widths, if possible. State width on entry form if not standard. Grooms may stand in both phases. Each phase is optional – indicate on entry form the phases you are entering.

**Location:** - Coxhill is 3 miles from Junction 4 of the M9, just off the A801. Entry to the yard is by a farm road on the right. It will be signposted as satnav directions for the farm are misleading!

**Competitors' information: -**

- Dressage times will be available from Barbara-Anne (01324 613948) or Dave (07759 612000) on **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October from 6.30 until 8.30 pm.**
- Coxhill is a working farm with approximately 20 livery horses. Please be aware of staff handling horses.
- Hard-standing is available for parking so the event is not dependent on weather. **Please report to the parking marshal on arrival** and wait to be directed to a parking area.
- Random checks on horse/pony passports, vaccinations and fire extinguishers will be undertaken.
- Indoor arena is 65m x 25m. The surface of the school is great, even for small ponies.
- The dressage arena will be available for half an hour before the competition starts for anyone wanting to familiarise their horse with the arena.
- **Dogs must be on leads at all times, and attached to humans!** If dogs are left at your vehicle, please ensure they are secure. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste bags appropriately.
