Closing Date for Entries: Monday 12th May - Late entries will be surcharged at £25.

Location: - Deer Park, Hopetoun Estate, Newton, Winchburgh, West Lothian, EH30 9SL. A904, via A90 or M9. In the village of Newton, turn north down the road signposted to Abercorn Church; pass the Parkhead Cottages on a narrow Z bend, ¼ mile further on down the hill turn right into the Deer Park through the security gates over a cattle grid.

Stabling: Please report to the stable manager on arrival and wait to be directed to a parking area. Rubber matting must be used on all stables and corrals. Electric fencing can be used with prior arrangement with the event organiser and there will be a designated parking area.

Additional vehicles: £10 per extra caravan, after the first one per competitor.

ATVs/Scooters: May be used to access the obstacles at competitors' risk. Not to be used in the obstacles as per BC rules. No cars beyond the forward (obstacle) parking area.

Dogs: Dogs on leads only. No dogs in obstacles or arenas. Please clear up and bin all dog waste.

Catering: Catering van on site from Thursday. Bar on site Friday & Saturday. Drinks reception on Friday evening, following Terrier Racing. Prizegiving, hog-roast and ceilidh on Saturday evening.
