- Indoor arena is 60m x 27m. The surface of the school is great, even for small ponies.
- The dressage arena will be available for half an hour before the competition starts for anyone wanting to familiarise their horse with the arena.
- **Dogs must be on leads at all times, and attached to humans!** If dogs are left at your vehicle, please ensure they are secure. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste bags appropriately.
- Please clear up after your pony/horse and take domestic rubbish home with you.
